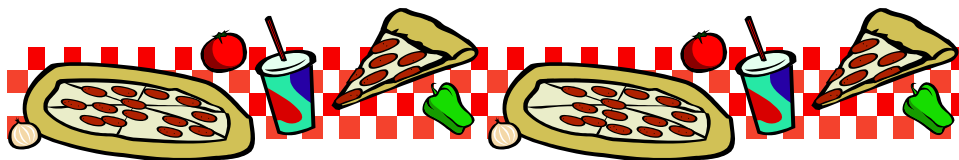

## VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR SENIOR HIGH WEDNESDAY LUNCHEONS

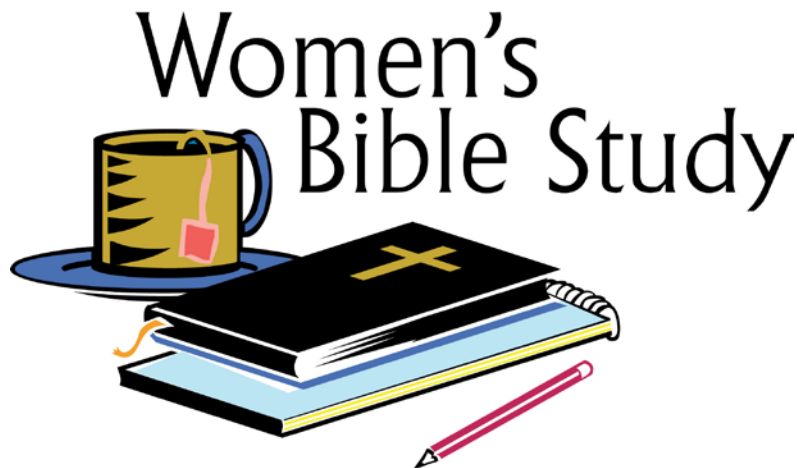

**MARK YOUR CALENDAR:** Dr. Richard Mouw will be our guest speaker on Sunday, September 26, 2010. Dr. Mouw has served as President of Fuller Theological Seminary since 1993, after having served the seminary for four years as Provost and Senior Vice President. A philosopher, scholar, and author, Mouw joined the faculty of Fuller Theological Seminary as professor of Christian philosophy and ethics in September 1985. Before coming to Fuller he served for 17 years as professor of philosophy at Calvin College in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He has also served as a visiting professor at the Free University in Amsterdam. On March 29, 2007 President Richard Mouw was awarded the Kuyper Prize at Princeton Theological Seminary. This prize is awarded annually to a scholar who has made a major contribution to Reformed public theology. As the 2007 recipient Dr. Mouw delivered a lecture entitled " Culture, Church and Civil Society: Kuyper for a New Century" to scholars from the United States, Canada, and the Netherlands.
